This Agreement made and entered into on this 1st Aug 2018 to 30st Aug 2023 between V. KAUSALAYAN MAHILA MAHAVIDYALAYA, DEORI and RUKHAMA MAHILA MAHAVIDYALAYA, NAWEGAON BANDH, Tah- Arjuni, Dist- Gondia.

The aforesaid Institutions are here in after referred to individually as institute and collectively as institutes.

It is the statutory object to disseminate advance knowledge by providing Academic, Laboratory training facilities as it may deem fit and it shall endeavor to provide students and teachers the necessary atmosphere and facilities for the promotion of:

1. OBJECTIVES OF THE MOU

- a) To promote interaction between VKMM, DEORI and RMM, NAWEGAON BANDH in jointly beneficial areas towards students' Academic & Technical Development.
- b) To provide a formal basis for initiating interaction between VKMM, DEORI and RMM, NAWEGAON BANDH.
- c) To promote and enhance academic interest between VKMM, DEORI and RMM, NAWEGAON BANDH.
- d) To promote Industrial Education & related education activities between institutions.

2. PROPOSED MODES OF COLLABORATION

VKMM, DEORI and RMM, NAWEGAON BANDH propose to collaborate through the following:

- a) Non-Commercial Cooperation and Promotion of Education and Training in areas of

mutual Interest.

- b) Any other below mentioned appropriate mode of interaction agreed upon between VKMM, DEORI and RMM, NAWEGAON BANDH.

Technical Areas of Collaboration

- a) Provide academic interaction by delivering special lectures at RMM, NAWEGAON BANDH on topics of relevance to home sciences.
- b) Provide necessary help in organizing Workshops/Conferences Programs at RMM, NAWEGAON BANDH for enhancement of skills for students of RMM, NAWEGAON BANDH.
- c) Usage of Academic Infrastructure of RMM, NAWEGAON BANDH for conducting Lectures/Workshops/ Technical Seminars.

a. Academic and Technical Seminars/ Workshops

VKMM, DEORI always give preference to keep the students well acquainted with contemporary issues in core & its related Industries and to keep pace with the changing environment, seminars/ workshops plays an vital role for development, we would organize this on Every Friday or Saturday, where our Institute experts will deliver Guest lectures, Speeches and demonstrations on recent trends (Topics) related to Home Sciences for faculty members and students. In order to improve students developing knack of handling interview & communication skills and to provide strong foundation of English languages communication workshops would be regularly organized as per mutual schedule which would also include building positive attitude, positive thinking, time management, developing interpersonal skills, developing listening skills and participation skills in group discussions etc

- a) During and for a period of Five years from the date of disclosure, each party agrees to consider as confidential all information disclosed by the other party in written or tangible form or, if orally disclosed confirmed in writing within thirty days of disclosure and identified as confidential by the disclosing party.
- b) The obligations above shall not extend to any confidential information for which the receiving party can prove that this information is in the public domain at the time of disclosure or comes within the public domain without fault of the receiving party. This is already known or become known to the receiving party is received from a third party having no obligations of confidentiality to the disclosing party. The relationship of the parties under this MOU shall be

nonexclusive and both parties, including their affiliates, subsidiaries and divisions, are free to pursue. Other agreements or collaborations of any kind. However, when entering into a particular agreement, the participants may agree to limit each party's right to collaborate with others on that subject.

This MOU, unless extended by mutual written agreement of the parties, shall expire 5 years after the effective date specified in the opening paragraph. This MOU may be amended or terminated earlier by mutual written agreement of the parties at any time. Either party shall have the right to unilaterally terminate this MOU upon 60 days prior written notice to the other party. However, no such early termination of this MOU, whether mutual or unilateral, shall affect the obligations of the participants under any Agreement, Confidentiality clause as referenced in clause 3 above, or any other agreement entered into pursuant to this MOU, which obligations shall survive any such termination. Nothing in this MOU shall be construed to make party a partner, an agent or legal representative of the other for any purpose.

It is understood by the Parties herein this MOU is based on the professional competence and expertise of each party and hence neither Party shall transfer or assign this Agreement, or rights or obligations arising hereunder, either wholly or in part, to any third party.

- a) The details for the efficacious implementation of this Memorandum of Understanding shall be jointly worked out on mutually acceptable terms within the parameters of the policies, rules and regulations of both the institutions.
- b) The parties to this memorandum may, by mutual consultant, add modify, amend, delete, review or revise any term(s) and condition(s) of this agreement.
- c) The intent and implementation of this memorandum is subject to the policies of the respective states (in case of international agreements) and the laws of the land.
- d) The parties to this **MOU** undertake to treat as **CONFIDENTIAL AND PRIVILEGED** information of the other institution, which is so classified in advance. The terms of confidentiality and mode of disclosure shall be as per mutually acceptable terms.
- e) This MOU shall require the ratification of the competent academic/executive body of both the institutions. This MOU is executed in duplicate with each copy being an official version of the Agreement and having equal legal validity. BY SIGNING

This MOU, unless extended by mutual written agreement of the parties, shall expire after the effective date specified in the opening paragraph. This MOU may be amended or terminated earlier by mutual written agreement of the parties at any time. Either party shall have the right to unilaterally terminate this MOU upon 60 days prior written notice to the other party. However, no such early termination of this

MOU, whether mutual or unilateral, shall affect the obligations of the participants under any Agreement, Confidentiality clause as referenced in clause 3 above, or any other agreement entered into pursuant to this MOU, which obligations shall survive any such termination. Nothing in this MOU shall be construed to make party a partner, an agent or legal representative of the other for any purpose.

It is understood by the Parties herein this MOU is based on the professional competence and expertise of each party and hence neither Party shall transfer or assign this Agreement, or rights or obligations arising hereunder, either wholly or in part, to any third party.

- a) The details for the efficacious implementation of this Memorandum of Understanding shall be jointly worked out on mutually acceptable terms within the parameters of the policies, rules and regulations of both the institutions.
- b) The parties to this memorandum may, by mutual consultant, add modify, amend, delete, review or revise any term(s) and condition(s) of this agreement.


